FCOM clinics rely on

Annually, FCOM clinics:

- Provide **107,097** patient visits
- Serve **38,130** unique patients
- Intake **14,605** new patients
 · *66% of clinics reported an increase in new patients*

- 95%** of clinics offer **RX Assistance**
- 83%** of clinics offer **Lab Services**
- 82%** of clinics offer **Health Education**
- 74%** of clinics provide **Primary Care**
- 67%** of clinics offer **Mammograms**
- 63%** of clinics offer **Mental Health Care**
- 55%** of clinics offer **Diabetes Support**
- 44%** of clinics offer **Vision**
- 41%** of clinics offer **Dental**

74% of clinics have operating budgets **below \$250,000**
